**Let's Make an Apple Volcano!**

What you need: An apple, White Vinegar, Baking Soda, Knife, an Adult, food coloring (Optional)

1. Cut a well into your apple cutting around the stem and toward the core, about one half way through apple
2. Place some baking soda into the well of your apple
3. Add food a few drops of food coloring if desired
4. 4. Add some vinegar and see what happens!
5. What does it look like? Does it smell? Is it hot or cold? Can it work using other fruits? Put your science minds to work and explore!

**ERUPTING APPLE-CANO**



### What you need:

- . Disposable plastic cup
- . Balloons
- . Scissors
- . Rubberband
- . Marshmallows

### Directions:

1. Use scissors to cut the bottom third of the disposable cup
2. Tie knot at the neck of the balloon and cut small amount off top of balloon
3. Stretch the balloon over the wider opening of the cup (this can be tricky! Use a rubber band to help hold the balloon in place.
4. Put marshmallows in the cup, pull back the balloon, aim and shoot!
